

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Sick is a sacrament of healing. It is the healing touch of Christ that the priest brings when we are seriously ill in body or spirit. When the priest anoints us with the blessed oil, Christ assures us, "I am healing you. I love you." We do not always know just what healing Christ will bring, but we have faith that He is with us. Fr. Gene shares the blessing of the sacrament for 9:00 a.m. Mass at St Joseph on the first Wednesday of each month and First Friday 9:00 a.m. Mass at Our Lady of the Lakes. You may also call either office anytime for an appointment to get anointed for things such as sickness or surgery. As a responsibility of our Baptism, we are all called to pray for others. St. Joseph and OLL have an active prayer ministry who daily pray for those who have made their need known. In addition to prayer, many who knit and crochet make shawls or blankets to give. It is a reminder that God's love and our community warms and surrounds them.
