Celebrate Catechetical Week with us this September! Adult FED (Forming Effective Disciples) facilitators, catechists and learners have the opportunity to retreat and relax at Camp Wehakee, N8104 Barker Lake Rd., Winter, WI 54896. Our retreat master, LIBBY ATKINSON, will present a series of reflections that emphasize the way of prayer and drawing close to Jesus. More specifically, she will look at the doctrine of spiritual childhood through the Gospel and the heart and teachings of St. Therese of Lisieux. Libby received a Master of Arts degree in Christian Spirituality from Creighton University, along with Certificates in Spiritual Direction and Retreat Giving. Summer Classes on Prayer-Why do we say that?

Each of our lives are filled with prayers with which we are familiar and, therefore, comfortable. This is despite the fact that many prayers contain words, expressions, and references that we don't understand. If we have a more clear understanding of these terms, our prayers would have more meaning for us and, perhaps make them more spiritually enriching. Why do we pray to "Our Father" when we are alone? Should we pray, "My Father?" Why do we frequently bless the "name" of God, rather than God Himself? What does "full" mean in the Hail Mary? Does Amen mean more than "the end?" We'll discuss these and other terms from prayers we know, as well as from some of our familiar hymns. Handouts will be provided, but bibles are always appropriate. There will be no charge, the food is delicious and the fellowship is fine. The presenter is OLL parishioner Charles Eldredge. He has taught several Adult Faith Formation classes in the last ten years. He is a graduate of St. Lukes Grade School, Cretin High School and St. Thomas College in St. Paul. He Also holds a master's degree in theological studies from the University of Dallas.
