



## Week's Pick

This week's Pick is Laura Merriott's non-profit foundation, Save Unborn Life. Most of us feel, as just one individual, that we can have little impact on protecting the lives of the vulnerable in an increasingly secular society that has grown cold and indifferent regarding pro-life issues. Laura Merriott, a practicing Catholic in Erie, PA, chose instead not shrink away intimidated. She has found a way to make a difference. How? After learning that many women who have abortions cite financial hardship as the reason, she decided to use her retirement savings to help. Working through a local women's center, Laura offers women \$3,000 to choose to carry their child to term. While \$3,000 seems insignificant compared to the amount of money it costs to get a child even through the first year of life, so far, 80 women have accepted the offer from Save Unborn Life, and all have expressed gratitude to the organization for helping them choose to bring their child into the world. Some of the women have put their child up for adoption, while others have decided to raise their child themselves. Since most of the women who have accepted the terms of this agreement—yes, each woman is required to sign a legal contract and prove that their child has been delivered before receiving the funds—live below the poverty line, they receive assistance through the government, so an additional \$3,000 has made a big difference. Several women have used the funds to further their education, while some have found better living conditions for their family. If nothing else, we can be inspired by the fact that one person can make a difference. By choosing to take action, Laura Merriott has helped bring 80 children into the world. By acting on God's grace, God's call, Laura Merriott has saved 80 lives. Inspiring!
