When does Lent 2018 start and end?

This year, Lent starts on February 14th which is also known as Ash Wednesday, and all families in our Faith Formation Program should attend Mass here at OLL at 6:30pm.

Lent is a 40-day fast, and goes until the summit of the Liturgical Year that is known as Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.
