


Pick of the Week

This week's Pick is Epiphany. In the Church, the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord recognizes the manifestation of Jesus Christ as God and Savior, not only of God's chosen people of the old covenant, but also of the Gentiles, represented by the Three Kings—Wise Men, Astronomers—who come to pay the baby Jesus homage with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. The word "Epiphany" is also defined as a moment of sudden insight of something once unknown. As this is the season when we make resolutions for the year ahead, is it possible to resolve to have a personal insight, an Epiphany, of the Epiphany? Can we resolve to make some time to contemplate the reality that God became Man and what that means to each of us in a personal way? After all, God did this for all of us and for each of us as well.
