Pastor's Notes

Years ago, I read an essay in which the writer commented that when he drives, he's usually putting more faith in Ford than he generally puts in God. That's a pretty startling thought for those of us who drive around calling ourselves Christians. How tentatively would I drive if my faith in the brakes were on a par with my faith in God? How daring would I be with the accelerator? The Book of Wisdom fleshes that out a bit by describing how the Israelites demonstrated their faith: They wore their running shoes to the Passover supper. That meal, the model for our Eucharist, was not planned to be a sit-down affair. Passover faith is a verb, not a noun. Our Gospel begins with Jesus telling his disciples to demonstrate their faith by giving everything away. He then tells them to obey the dress code for Passover by having their loins girt, ready for the road. Jesus said this to the disciples accompanying him on his road. These women and men had left home and family and had already heard that they are headed for Jerusalem where he would be captured and killed. As if to get them ready for that, he tells them to leave their fear behind with their possessions. Fr Gene
